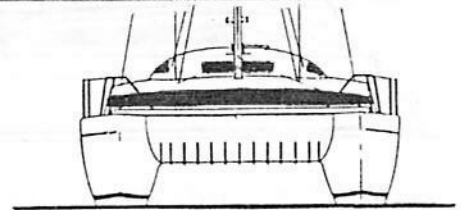
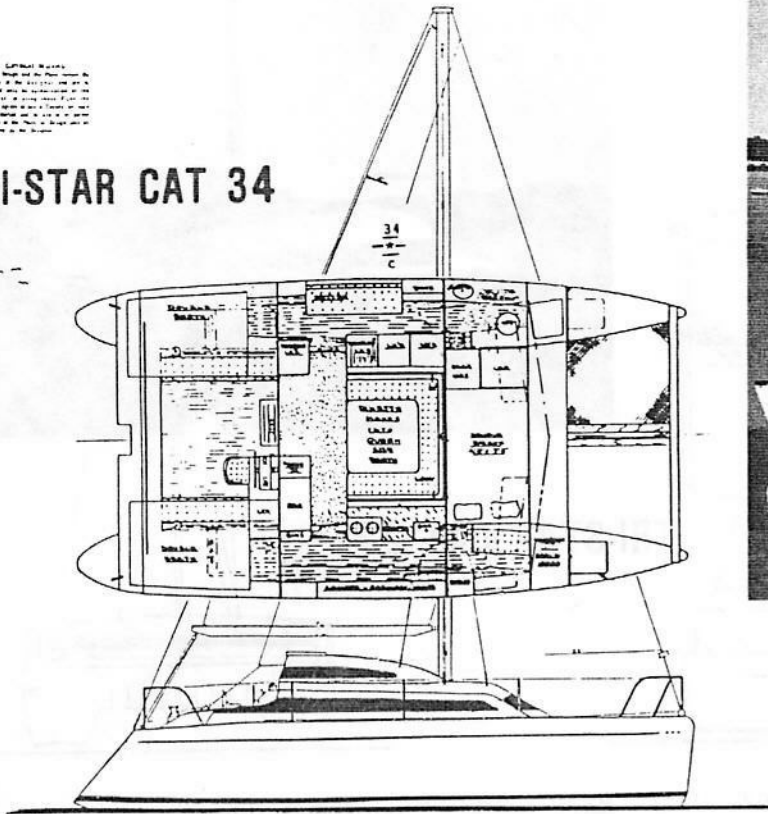


# NEW CRUISING CATAMARANS BY ED HORSTMAN

## TRI-STAR CAT 34

CAT 34, designed as a mid-size comfortable, quick sailing catamaran with comfortable accommodations, a spacious bridge deck lounge area that has 6' headroom. The galley is located in the starboard hull where there is 6'9" headroom and the room for a fully equipped galley for easy meal preparation. The galley may be open to the bridge deck lounge area. CAT 34 has three separate private cabin areas that have full size berths and lockers. The master cabin is forward and has it's own dressing and locker area in the starboard hull. The master cabin has a private door on the port side that separates it from the spacious shower, water closet and sink area. CAT 34 has the load carrying ability and interior room to be a great cruising catamaran. CAT 34 spacious interior is designed into long water line length hull shapes for fast sailing and comfortable passages. CAT 34 has a large comfortable cockpit for both sailing and lounging enjoyment. The cockpit may be protected at anchor with a boom tent and a dodger at sea. Decks are layed out for moving about under sail with the spacious forward deck having webbing that can be walked on for sail handling, anchoring or the webbing is a great place for sunbathing and fish watching. CAT 34 may be built fast and easily using Tri-Star's comprehensive plans which include full size patterns, so all you do is mark, cut and build. Cat 34's hull shapes are designed using Tri-Star's constant radius hull lines for maximum performance, functionality and ease of construction. Tri-Star's comprehensive plans and full size patterns are drawn with the first time builder in mind. Plans also come with the designer's 272 page construction book that covers building from start to launching. CAT 34 by Ed Horstman is a roomy, fast sailing, non-heeling catamaran, her shallow draft hulls allow sailing where others dare not plus she may be beached for a shore party. CAT 34 owners will enjoy her comfortable accommodations and will find her easy to build and a joy to sail, anywhere.
