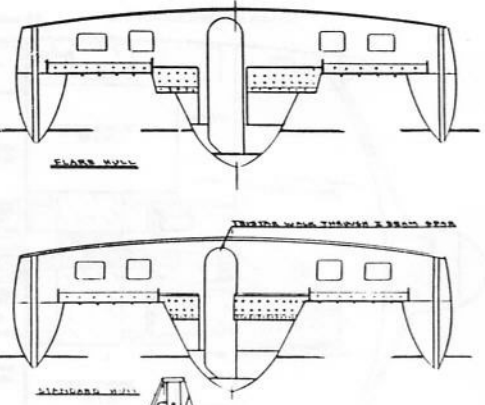
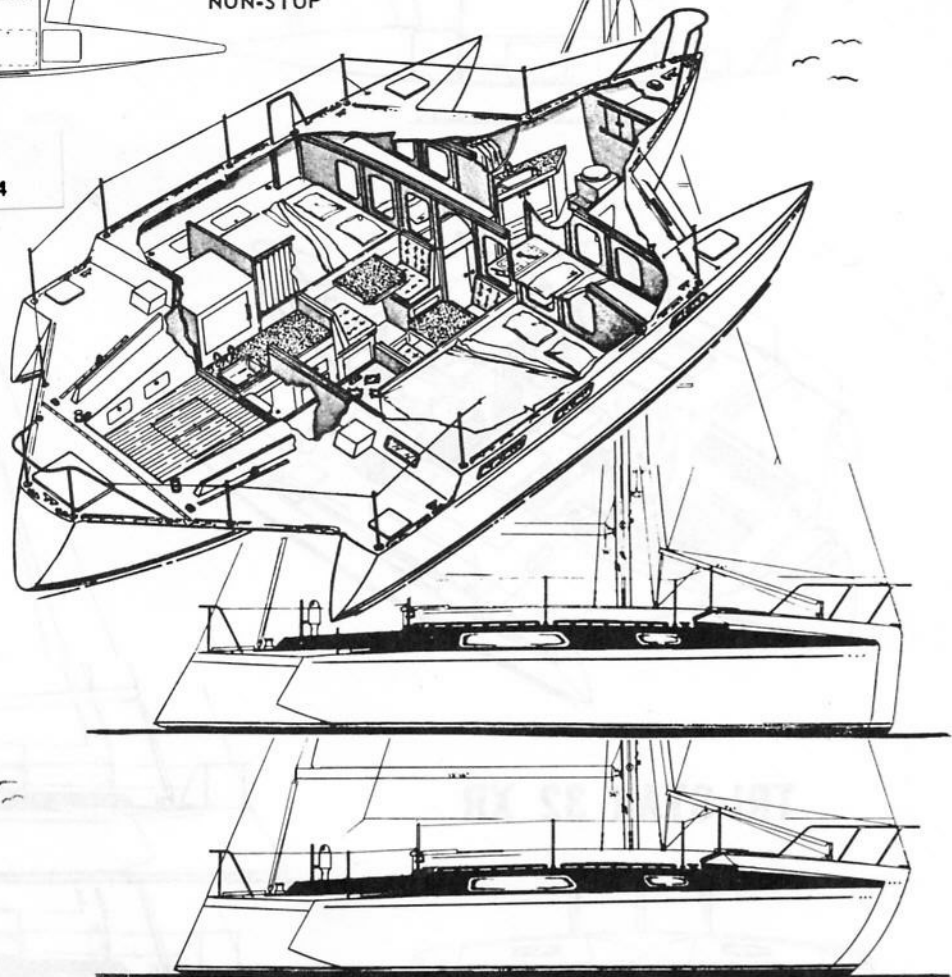

"Where To Build" This TRI-STAR 30 "Small-Tri" was built in the back yard. Cost \$186.50 to crane over house, \$85.00 to trailer and launch 15 miles away in the Sacramento River.

TRI-STAR 31, a seaworthy Trimaran that anyone may cruise the world in. She will sleep 6 in spacious wing berths that take up none of the interior and with curtains may be enclosed for privacy. The "TRI-STAR Dinette" will seat 6 people very comfortably and a testimonial to the functionality of the Tri-Star's dinette arrangement is that it now is found in most designs. When seated at the dinette you are at window level so you may enjoy the view out. A spacious full head room completely private head and hanging locker area forward are features found only on TRI-STAR's flush deck designs, a shower may be optional. TRI-STAR 31 flush deck unitized construction and deep "I" beam spars make her strong while giving the sleeping accommodations in the wing. Remember a bunk with no one in it is next to nothing in weight. Strength with functionality with no extra structural weight. TRI-STAR 31 underwing clearance is matched with a maximum of only 5'3" height from the DWL to the mast step. This sleekness provides the lowest possible windage and adds even more to the overall performance. TRI-STAR 31 has windward ama's and removable dagger boards in each ama making her performance to windward unbeatable. Constructed with developed round bottom hulls that give a minimum of wetted area while giving the greatest load carrying capacity for ample cruising supplies. TRI-STAR 31 designed to be a comfortable, fast ocean cruising-racing Trimaran.
